Weather permitting, other outdoor activities will provide fresh air fun for all ages such as skating, games, snowman building and an open fire for roasting marshmallows.



Doing our Part, One Bucket at a Time

Clean water cannot be taken for granted. Lefroy Harbour has adopted a new initiative to keep our water clear of waste, through the installation of a

Seabin Project waste collector.

This floating device continuously sucks debris into an electrically powered filtration system with a filter. As it runs, it collects up to 20 kilograms of waste, daily, and even absorbs oil.

Australians Pete Ceglinski and Andrew Turton, two oceanlovers, created Seabins as an answer to the problem of plastics in the ocean. This innovative solution has newly arrived in Ontario.



Prepare to Launch: Book your Spring Service



Our annual **service reminder letter** has gone out. Many tune-ups are required annually, and maintaining your boat prevents wear and tear over time. Please book your service now to prevent disappointment, and possible extra haul-out and re-launch charges. Technicians can easily access your boat for bottom painting, drive services, tune-ups, or to service impellers at this time of year while the ice provides access. **Please book now before the ice melts!** You may also want to **review your inventory** of consumable items, such as batteries for flashlights, or items that the children tend to grow out of each season, such as PFDs.

approved VHF Radio Operator's course. Includes the new DSC endorsement.



A Restricted Radiotelephone Operator's Certificate, or a ROC(M), is now a legal requirement for any operator of a marine radio. Sail Canada, a federally approved provider, is offering a course at Lefroy this spring. The \$115 fee includes instruction and course materials, the exam and the certificate, which does not expire.
